The role will involve building trusting relationships with people, empowering them to take control of their wellbeing and health by giving them time to focus on 'what matters to me' and the 5 Ways to Wellbeing; and then supporting them to connect to groups and activities. You will have good IT, numeracy and literacy skills and preferably have experience of working in the not-for-profit sector, although this is not essential.
